**Executive Board Monthly Meeting  
May 11, 2016**

The Executive Board Monthly Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. Motion to approve the minutes 1<sup>st</sup> – Daun Cooper, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Janet Hey. Motion passed.

**President's Report – Michele Byington**

Michele Byington reported that the new budget passed and will be reviewed in detail at the June meeting.

A status of the 2<sup>nd</sup> directors position was explained. Michele Byington asked that we remain respectful to the administration and the process as this has the full support of Mr. Trybus. Our band numbers look to grow in 2016-2017.

Registration for Band will be July 21, 2016.

Mr. Line unveiled the new uniform and the county will pay \$85,000. Students will be fitted next weel and the new uniforms will be available in mid October. Michele Tibbetts mad a motion to approve \$1446 to be spent on the inclusion of snaps in the bibbers making the alteration costs less. 2nd – Debbie Felty. Motion passed. 250 uniforms will be ordered.

Mr. Line explained a summer rehearsal schedule and the staff will meet on Monday. These rehearsals will be voluntary and will be from 6-8:00 pm. Percussion dates have been included on the band calendar. Some chaperones may be necessary.

The show for next year will be "Imagine" . Music has been reviewed. Regions Bank will be providing 20 bikes as props. A t shirt logo will be sent to Lisa Scheffler.
