Concession revenue has been exceeding prior years and Hagerty was a very big night for our Band revenue. Homecoming was 20% over last year. We are in need of volunteers for this Friday's game. Planning for 10/29 soccer, Lyman 10/30 and Preview 10/31 is underway. Soccer sign ups will go in the band room tonight for students. Volunteers are needed this week.

Cheesecake canvassing went well. 356 cheesecakes were sold for \$6,003 (gross) with \$2,239.37 received in donations. This results in \$4,442.47 BBA profit. Student Sales were \$10,563 cheesecakes were sold and \$209 donated. \$2,837.71 goes to students accounts and OHSBBA profit is \$1,126.59. As a comparison, in 2014, we sold 370 (\$6,333 gross) with \$1,71.25 in profit. The biggest sellers were Kendall Bergman, Angela Danforth, Christopher Fassi, Natalie Fetter, Michael Johnson, Emilee Trosper who sold \$573 in cheesecakes to a Glen Eagle A community. Delivery is scheduled for November 7.

Spring fundraisers are being looked at now. The idea of magnets being offered along with a cash donation drive is being researched.
