E-mailed report:

We concluded Varsity football with Homecoming - we have inventory to see us through Soccer with very little purchasing required. We had leftover Chick Fil A - volunteers purchased some and we donated the rest to the band seniors, first then anyone who wanted one (52). Soccer is going well - our new parent team has covered most of the games and students are signing up.

Food for States is being ordered through Firehouse Subs (same as last year) with a pick up time of 11:15. Michele's friends will pick up. Water has already been purchased and will be loaded (as well as ice) Friday evening/Saturday.

Fundraising – Marge Maturo

Marge Maturo introduced Brandon Schaefer of Snap Raise who discussed how his company can help the band fundraise. Snap Raise creates a social donation platform on the web through which donors can pay with credit/debit cards. Band students would provide a list of family/friends to whom the web site would be shared via e-mail/FB/twitter/text. The web site is private and can only be seen by those to whom it has been shared. The average donation is \$50/student. Typically 60% of donations come from outside the local community. A tax receipt can be given for donations. A similar school-based organization raised \$11,000 this year. The band would keep 70% of donations with the possibility of a 7% bonus if a 70% participation is reached. The board agreed that Snap Raise would work best with a kick-off during band camp at the beginning of marching season and Marge will book Snap Raise for July/Aug with the date to be finalized once band camp dates are out.

Marge suggested a Springs sales fundraiser, Butter Braid Bread. Items sell for \$14/piece, of which the band keeps \$6. It was agreed that this would be best done in February on a personal sales basis, no group canvassing, followed by Bucks for Band sometime in April. Marge will follow up with Butter Braid.

BJ's Brewhouse offer fundraising nights. If you go in with a flyer on selected dates, the organization will receive 20% of the check excluding alcohol sales. Marge will try and get a date close to the December showcase and the band will consider further nights in spring.

Texas Roundhouse offer fundraising nights where up to 10 students can act as host but the band would receive only 10% and the committee felt that the students were already busy enough.
